What is the purpose of this update?


Description of this fund

The Fund invests in assets with very low risk of negative return and with minimal fluctuations in returns. It is very unlikely to achieve high returns. The investment return objective aims to maintain the real value of investments over the short term.

What are the risks of investing?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the Fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

How has the fund performed?

Example of how this applies to an investor

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Mary had \$10,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Mary received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$238 (that is 2.38% of her initial \$10,000). Mary also paid \$0.00 in other charges. This gives Mary a total return after tax of \$172 for the year.


What does the fund invest in?
